

COMEDY CAPERS gang Show

APPLICATION PROCESS
2020

Please read carefully so that the process is as smooth as possible and correctly completed.

All members of CCGS are required to be members of the Scout Association, as either a uniformed member or as an adult volunteer. This year there is a new way to apply to be a member of Comedy Capers Gang Show. In line with Scouts SA, CCGS will use the MyScout SA system in place of application forms for all members.

To apply for Comedy Capers Gang Show, you need to complete the following steps.

Step 1—Registering For Auditions - Cast only

- 1. Follow the link to Trybookings. The link is: https://www.trybooking.com/BFOZY
- 2. Register and select one audition session. <u>Each person attending the audition must have a separate</u> booking

in their own name please.

You will receive a confirmation email from Trybookings, but you will not receive an additional email to confirm your booking from CCGS. Just come on the day and time you have booked. We will be expecting you and you will not need a ticket.

Step 2—CCGS Membership Application Process - Cast and Crew

You will need to log onto MyScout SA https://sa.myscout.com.au/events/55/registration to complete Comedy Capers 2020 season event.

To log on to MyScout please follow the attached link, you will need your date of birth and/or your Scout member number.

- 1. If you do not know you Scout member number, you can access it by contacting your Scout Group or if you have been a member of Comedy Capers in the past you can contact the Admin Director Terri Scanlon.
- 2. If you are a Girl Guide please contact the Admin Director Terri Scanlon who will be able to assist you.
- 3. If you do not have a Scout membership number and are not currently a member of Scouts SA Branch, please contact the Admin Director Terri Scanlon to see how we can process your application. All members of CCGS and the Scouts SA are required to hold a current National Police Clearance, and in line with current legislation a Working With Children Certificate (we are able to assist with this process).

Once in the event application you will need to confirm that you have read and understood the information. You will also need to update your medical, dietary and emergency contact details. Clink on the update contact details, once you have saved these it will take you to update you medical information, please clink on the Enter medical details on the top right hand corner.

Step 3—CareMonkey - Cast and Crew

If you are successful in being accepted as part of the Comedy Capers Cast or Crew, you will then be sent a link to register for CareMonkey (our admin and welfare system). If you already have a profile please share with CCGS, alternatively if you don't have a CareMonkey profile you will need to create one. To participate in CCGS activities all Cast and Crew members must be registered on CareMonkey.
