

## COMEDY CAPERS gang Show

**APPLICATION PROCESS - 2021** 

Please read carefully so that the process is as smooth as possible and correctly completed.

All members of CCGS are required to be members of the Scout Association, as either a uniformed member or as an adult volunteer. CCGS uses the Scouts SA 'MyScout' system for management of members of the 'Comedy Capers 2021' activity event and Operoo (formerly 'CareMonkey') for the administrational management, contact and medical information.

## **CHANGES DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMEIC:**

Due to the ever evolving nature of the COVID-19 pandemic and the arts, there will be many changes to Comedy Capers Gang Show for 2021. As always our mission is to use performing arts to instil the principles of Scouting in young people, so helping them to become more confident, capable and valued citizens, to give an enriched and rewarding performing arts experience and to enhance the reputation of Scouting within the membership and amongst the broader community. We ask for patience and understanding as the Executive and Leadership teams navigate through this challenging time.

**CAST:** Positions are limited due to COVID requirements and physical distancing both during rehearsals and in the theatre. For the 2021 season there will be 2 enrolment rounds in lieu of the normal auditions. Round 1 will be open to eligible Cast or Crew from the 2020 season (Eligibility: 1/ Hold current registration with Scouts SA or Girl Guides SA as a uniformed member. 2/ Have been excepted into the CCGS Cast or Crew for 2020).

If following round 1 there are still cast positions available, round 2 cast applications will be held and will be open to the wider Scouting members (at the discretion of the Production Director). An audition process for new cast applications would be held in late January. **CREW:** Positions are limited due to COVID requirements and physical distancing both during rehearsals and in the theatre. There may be changes to departments, roles, tasks and a reduced theatre roster to maintain our COVID Safe Plan.

To apply for Comedy Capers Gang Show, you need to complete the following steps.

Round 1- Enrolling For A Cast Position – Existing Cast (or crew) only

- 1. Respond to the email from Operoo (formally CareMonkey) by
- 2. Enrolling as a 2021 cast member. Each person registering must have a separate response.

A welcome letter will be sent from CCGS with your acceptance and further information regarding the MyScout activity registration, Operoo and specific season information.

## Registering For A Crew Position - Crew only

- 1. Respond to the email from Operoo (formally CareMonkey) and select whether you are returning to CCGS for 2021.
- 2. Log onto MyScout SA <a href="https://sa.myscout.com.au/events/96/registration">https://sa.myscout.com.au/events/96/registration</a> to complete Comedy Capers 2021 season event. (Once you follow the above link, you will need your Scout member number or your date of birth).
- 3. Choose your crew department preference.
- 4. Update your medical, dietary and emergency contact details. Clink on the update contact details, once you have saved these it will take you to update you medical information, please click on the 'Enter medical details' top right hand corner.

## NOTE:

- a. If you do not know you Scout member number, you can access it by contacting your Scout Group or if you have been a member of Comedy Capers in the past you can contact the Admin Director Terri Scanlon.
- b. If you do not have a Scout membership number and are not currently a member of Scouts SA Branch, please contact the Admin Director Terri Scanlon to see how we can process your application. All members of CCGS and Scouts SA are required to hold a current National Police Clearance, Working With Children Certificate and complete all Scouts SA mandatory online training (we are able to assist with this process).
- c. If you are a Girl Guide without a Scout number, please contact the Admin Director Terri Scanlon who will assist you.
